- Aggressive investigation into any substantive consumer fraud of pharmaceutical companies who deceived Missouri citizens about the efficacy and the safety of COVID-19 and mRNA vaccinations.
- Aggressive investigation into any substantive allegation of any entities, organizations, or agents (including but not limited to state or local health departments, state medical boards, and schools) that succumb to fear-based tactics to silence, threaten, harass, financially disincentive, or harm any agent or organization that practices a professional duty of questioning or criticizing vaccine or gene modifying mRNA agents or any other agent even if it directly challenges the policies and laws being implemented.
